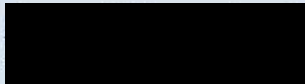

Folding fire pit 'campdelite'

For all those that love fire whilst camping , check out the campdelite folding fire pit. <http://www.campdelite.com/>

I bought one a few weeks back off ebay and have used it three times now. Fantastic bit of kit, which uses the compressed fire logs you get from Asda and B&M bargains. Saved me hauling around my cast fire pit, bags and bags of wood and firelighters. Simple to use, clean, doesn't burn the grass and cheap to run compared to all the usual stuff. Left no mess.

Searched the net prior to buying and the only other pit I could find was from Australia, which burns wood.

Packs up flat and seem robust enough to last a while.

I also used it at a camp site last week which doesn't allow fires. They said nothing!
